

## Harley-Davidson Raffle Official Rules Lottery License #M801257

Thank you for your interest in the raffle for a 2017 Harley-Davidson ST-Fatboy Low S motorcycle. By entering this charity raffle, you are stating that you have read the raffle rules and understand them. Three hundred (300) tickets will be printed. Tickets are not tax deductible. Tickets have no cash value. The odds of winning will depend on the number of tickets sold. All inquiries, on the "odds of winning" are to be made to the licensee prior to the purchase of a ticket. The total value of the prize is \$29,400.28.

- 1. Ticket purchasers must be a minimum of 18 years of age. Tickets cannot be purchased in the name of a person less than 18 years of age. Tickets must be sold and purchased in the Province of Ontario. While physically in Ontario, residents of other countries or provinces may purchase raffle tickets sold under a license issued in Ontario.
- 2. Postdated cheques cannot be accepted as payment for the purchase of tickets.
- 3. The licensee shall validate all tickets submitted for the draw; under no circumstances will unpaid or ineligible tickets be entered into the draw.
- 4. Personal information provided by the purchaser is used solely by the CMHA-WECB.
- 5. The following persons are prohibited from purchasing tickets (Pursuant to AGCO Regulations): CMHA-WECB Board of Directors, employees of CMHA-WECB, including their immediate families living at the same residence.
- 6. Entrants need not be present at drawing to win.
- 7. Raffle starts on August 30, 2017 and ends no later than October 27, 2017. Tickets are \$150.00 each. No more than a total of 300 tickets will be sold. Tickets will be sold through October 27, 2017 or until 300 tickets are sold, whichever occurs first.
- 8. One (1) Grand Prize winner will be drawn at a random draw on October 27, 2017 at the Water's Edge Event Centre, 2879 Riverside Dr. E., Windsor, Ontario.
- 9. Any prizes which are not claimed must be secured or placed in safekeeping for a period of six (6) months from the date of the draw. If at that time the prize has still not been claimed, the prize or monies equivalent to the fair market value of the prize must be donated to a beneficiary approved by the licensing authority.
- 10. Upon issuance of a raffle ticket, all sales are final and non-refundable. Ticket is non-transferrable.
- 11. The prize will be awarded free and clear of any lien or other encumbrances.
- 12. Prize may not be exactly as shown in the advertising materials.
- 13. The winning number will be published online at windsoressex.com/rockyoursole by October 31, 2017. The winner will be notified by phone and given complete instructions on how to redeem the winning prize. The winner must agree to use their name and likeliness for publicity purposes by the CMHA-WECB.
- 14. The Canadian Mental Health Association, Windsor-Essex County Branch (CMHA-WECB), and members of the Rock Your Sole organizing committee assume no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, illegible, or non-delivered entries. Any mutilated, incomplete or illegible entries will be deemed invalid and shall be immediately disqualified.

- 16. Winner is responsible for arranging, paying for, and showing proof of vehicle licensing and liability insurance before the prize may be claimed. The CMHA-WECB is not responsible for the delivery of the prize. The winner will be put in contact with Thunder Road Harley-Davidson to claim their prize of a 2017 Harley-Davidson ST-Fatboy Low S VIN #5HD1JT9AXHC012009.
